(c) Phrasal Preposition → Along with / because of /
with regard / According / instead of / owing to /
in spite of / in place of / in case of etc.

(d) Participle preposition → Verb + ing

Annoyed - (with) = Person

Ex - (i) He was annoyed at my laughing.

(ii) He annoyed with me.
